OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Setting up of Task Force (Committee of Secretaries) and Cell on Deregulation.

The Government of India has taken several important measures towards ease of living for the general public, and towards ease of doing business for businesses, especially MSMEs. A variety of steps have been taken including the passing of the Jan Vishwas Act, 2023.

2. At the recent Chief Secretaries' Conference held from 13th to 15th December 2024, one of the issues highlighted was the need to take practical and concerted steps in regard to State-level regulations and compliances, apart from further reducing regulatory and compliance burden at the Central level.

3. In pursuance of the deliberations at the Conference, it has been decided to set up a Deregulation Cell in the Cabinet Secretariat under the Secretary (Coordination) to help States in reforming and simplifying regulations and procedures. The Cell will also monitor efforts towards regulatory simplification and reform in the Government of India. NITI Aayog's and DPIIT's resources will also support this Cell.

4. Further, it has been decided to set up a Committee of Secretaries chaired by the Cabinet Secretary to act as a Task Force on Compliance Reduction & Deregulation, which will be supported by the Cell. It will have the following composition:


