Dear Chandra Bhushan,

As you are aware that a task force has been constituted as a Committee of Secretaries under the Chairmanship of Cabinet Secretary for Compliance Reduction and Deregulation to assist states and Union Territories (UTs) in reforming and simplifying regulations and procedures related to Ease of Doing Business and Ease of Living in the identified priority areas. In this context, a meeting with all the states and UTs was also conducted under the Chairpersonship of the Cabinet Secretary on 25<sup>th</sup> February 2025.

- 2. Chairman IWAI, a member of the taskforce, has been assigned the Union Territory of **Andaman and Nicobar** along with a team of officers from Cabinet Secretariat, DPIIT, MSME and NITI Aayog as annexed **(Annexure 1)**. As discussed, the date of visit to **Sri Vijaya Puram** is scheduled for **22**<sup>nd</sup> **March**, **2025**.
- 3. State/UT specific docket with details regarding the identified priority areas Land use, Building & Construction Regulations, Labour Reforms, Utilities and Permissions and Overarching Priorities (**Detailed list as Annexure 2**) has already been shared on 10<sup>th</sup> March 2025.
- 4. The broad suggested agenda of the visit include:
  - a) Meeting with the Chief Secretary and Senior Officials of departments concerned in the forenoon

The meeting will aim to discuss and advance the agenda on compliance reduction and deregulation. Indicative list of the concerned departments for this meeting is **annexed (Annexure 3)**. The focus area would be status and current readiness w.r.t. compliance reduction and deregulation, action plan along with milestones/tentative timelines for the way forward in the identified priority areas as listed in the respective state dockets.

b) Meeting with Industry Associations and Stakeholders in the afternoon

The team will also interact with representatives of national level/ UT level apex industry associations (CII, FICCI, ASSOCHAM, MSME associations, etc.) to understand their concerns with respect to the identified priority areas.

- 5. It is requested to appoint a Nodal Officer for coordination with the taskforce. Further, a deregulation cell may also be setup to oversee the implementation of identified action points across all priority areas.
- 6. It is further requested to make the logistics arrangements including transportation and accommodation for the entire team and arrange meetings as mentioned in para 4 above. Detailed travel plans for the entire team shall be shared shortly with the Nodal Officer.
